Matter for Sub-Committee Decision

RSW 306 Objection to Orui Road Consent Charges

The Committee had met earlier that afternoon with Messrs Glen Meredith and Gus Blithe to hear their concerns regarding the costs related to the consent. The Committee noted the difficulties caused by the poor quality advice given by the applicant's consultant, but were of the view that in the circumstances the charges should now be reduced to the standard fee that applies before any additional charges are levied.

The Committee was also concerned about the scale of the monitoring requirements in the consent and considered that these conditions should be reviewed.
