### 3. Non-notified resource consents

A total of 79 resource consents were approved between 1 August 2008 and 26 September 2008. These are summarised in the table below.

### **3.1 Consent trends**

This compares to a total of 35 granted in the previous reporting period (1 July 2008 to 31 July 2008).

### **3.2 Significant non-notified resource consents**

#### **S Griffith (The Poplars Industrial Park)WAR 080377**

Multiple consents approved relating to an industrial subdivision involving earthworks (and therefore sediment laden discharges), culverts, stream reclamation, and stream diversion in the East-West watercourse, on Ngaumutawa Rd, east of Masterton.

#### **Land Information New Zealand WAR 080332**

Three consents approved for installing a tsunami monitoring system on the headland at Castlepoint.

#### **S Hancock WGN 0080276**

Multiple consents approved for undertaking tracking and soil disturbance, vegetation clearance, and discharges of sediment arising from bulk earthworks, all of which are associated with a forestry operation close to Otaki township.

#### **Kapiti Coast District Council WGN 090016**

Four consents approved for replacing existing consents to irrigate sports fields with the Kapiti District.

#### **Pater Estate Ltd WAR 090009**

Consent approved for the installation of an upgraded on-site wastewater treatment and disposal system for the Paekakariki Shopping Centre. In 2007, the previous system failed, and an abatement notice required the landowner to upgrade the on-site wastewater and treatment disposal system.
