Request for information 2022 - 205

I refer to your request for information dated 6 November 2022, which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 7 November 2022. You have requested the following:

"Please provide a copy of any forestry consent relating to logging of the Levack Forest, Mangaone North Road, Hautere, 5582 by P F Olsen. In particular, I am interested in the boundary of the land to be cleared as it relates to Mangaone North Road and also the hours within which forestry activities with heavy machinery can operate on week days and on weekends."

Greater Wellington's response follows:

We have refused the part of your request relating to a forestry consent under section 17(e) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act) on the basis that the document alleged to contain the information requested does not exist.

No forestry consent can be provided for Levack Forestry because this harvesting operation is being conducted under permitted activity rules under the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Plantation Forestry) Regulations 2017 (NES-PF). Please find in Attachment 1 a harvest plan that shows the planned boundary of land to be harvested.

Activities related to noise and vibration are found in section 98 and 99 of the NES-PF. In section 98 it specifies limits on noise levels during certain times of the day:

- Monday to Saturday, daytime 75dB LAeq (15 min) between 7am and 7pm, at any assessment point where forestry noise is received for 20 weeks or less in a year
- Monday to Saturday, daytime 70 dB LAeq (15 min) between 7am and 7pm, at any assessment point where forestry noise is received for more than 20 weeks in a year
- Sunday daytime 45 dB LAeq (15 min) between 7am and 7pm
- Night time 45 dB LAeq (15 min) between 7 pm and the following 7am
- Monday to Saturday 120 dB LZpeak for any blasting between 7am and 7pm

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this letter, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.

Please note that it is our policy to proactively release our responses to official information requests where possible. Our response to your request will be published shortly on Greater Wellington's website with your personal information removed.
